SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PARTS ONE AND TWO

1. JURISDICTION

- (1) Each Meeting is a National (Clubmans) Race Meeting organised by The Circuit Club Incorporated at Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park, Taupō and promoted by TMP Limited, the owner and operator of Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park Taupō.
- (2) Each Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Four, Schedule Z being the Standing Regulations for all Race Meetings and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements of the National Sporting Code.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION

- 3.1** Each event will be a National (Clubmans) Race Meeting.
- 3.2** Race groups will be determined after Qualifying.

3.3 Race groups and the schedule of races will be published at the Race Secretary's Office after qualifying.

3.4 Each race group will have a minimum of three (3) races of 6 laps each:

- (1) Race One – grid start, fastest to slowest on best laps from Qualifying.
- (2) Race Two – handicap start on best laps from Qualifying or Race One.
- (3) Race Three – handicap start on best laps from Qualifying, Race One or Race Two.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 How to enter:

- (1) Any entry will not be valid until payment is received.
- (2) Entries may be emailed, posted, or submitted at Documentation. All entries must be made on the Official Entry Form.
- (3) The original of each emailed entry form must be supplied at Documentation.
- (4) Entries submitted before the Ordinary Entry Closing Date (see below) should be sent to:

- (5) The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the applicable provisions of the National Sporting Code.
- (6) **Acceptance** – Given that these are “low key” meetings, no formal acceptance of entry will be posted. Competitors can therefore assume that provided they have completed an entry form fully and included with it the appropriate entry fee, that the Organiser will accept their entry.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

5. **COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING**

5.1 **Licence Requirements:**

- (1) All drivers must hold as a minimum a C Grade Competition Licence.
- (2) If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 **Competitor Understanding:**

In submitting their entry, competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- (1) The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations;
- (2) Schedule Z Articles detailing Flag signals and Code of Conduct; and
- (3) The Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel Storage and Handling.

5.3 All competitors must wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A of the National Sporting Code.

5.4 **Drivers' Briefings**

- (1) **New Drivers:** Any driver(s) who have not previously competed at the circuit must indicate the fact on their entry form and attend the New Competitors' Briefing. Subject to (3) below, this briefing will be held at 09:00 at a place announced by PA announcement prior to the meeting. Attendance is compulsory and a roll-call will be made.
- (2) **All Drivers:** Subject to (3) below, this briefing will be held at 09:00 at a place announced by PA announcement prior to the meeting. Attendance is compulsory and a roll-call will be made.
- (3) The location and method of holding each briefing may change, meeting to meeting, according to the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the meeting.

6. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 Documentation: Documentation will take place at the Race Secretary's Office on the day of the Meeting from 08:00 – 08:45 or, if compliance with the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the meeting requires a different location or method, at the location/by the method notified to entrants by the Organiser prior to or upon the driver's arrival at the Meeting.

6.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Scrutineering will take place at the same time as documentation at the Scrutineering Pavilion. Competitors will be advised at Documentation if their vehicle has been selected for an audit. Competitors should assume that their vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence, is in readiness to be taken to the audit venue immediately after they have completed Documentation. If compliance with the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the meeting requires a different location or method, the audit will take place at the location/by the method notified to entrants by the Organiser prior to or upon the driver's arrival at the Meeting.

7. POSTPONEMENT AND CANCELLATION

7.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, if less than 30 entries are received for a Meeting by the **Ordinary Entry Closing Date** for that meeting, the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

8. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

8.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

9. GENERAL INFORMATION

9.1 Fuel: Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the Motorsport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel Handling. This can be found on the Motorsport NZ website – www.motorsport.org.nz.

9.2 Alcohol: Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

10. TIMEKEEPING

- (1) All cars will be electronically timed using the AMB Transponder System.
- (2) All competitors must have an operational AMB transponder approved for car or motorcycle racing, fitted for all testing, qualifying sessions and races.
- (3) For those competitors who do not have their own transponder, hire units are available from the Race Secretary's office. The hire charge is \$20.00 (incl. GST of \$2.61) per day and is in addition to the Entry Fee. Competitors who competed in the Sprint event the day before a Meeting and hired a transponder for that event need to pay a second hire fee for the Meeting.
