1. JURISDICTION

- (1) Each event is a ClubSport Advanced Circuit Sprint (Dual Car and Multi Car) organised by The Circuit Club Incorporated at Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park, Taupō and promoted by TMP Limited, the owner and operator of Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park Taupō.
- (2) Each event will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements of the National Sporting Code.
- (3) The MotorSport NZ Permit Numbers are:

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION

3.1 Each event will be a ClubSport Advanced Circuit Sprint (Dual Car and Multi Car).

- 3.2** Classes: Vehicles will be divided into classes as follows:
- (1) **Qualifying** – all cars single file from Pit Exit at 5 second intervals.
 - (2) **Dual sprints** –
 - Classes of 10 cars based on lap times throughout the event.
 - One Class per dual sprint, leaving the grid fastest to slowest at 5 second intervals.
 - All drivers must hold as a minimum a Temporary M Grade Competition Licence.
 - Temporary M Grade Competition Licences may be purchased from the MotorSport NZ Steward on the day. A test is required
 - (3) **Multi Car sprint** –
 - Held after dual sprints have concluded
 - Each grid, fastest to slowest cars
 - Grids of up to 6 cars
 - Each driver must have competed in two (2) dual sprints on the day and hold a full (not temporary) M Grade Licence.
 - Up to four (4) laps of the circuit.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 How to enter:

- (1) Any entry will not be valid until payment is received.
- (2) Entries may be emailed, posted, or submitted at Documentation. All entries must be made on the Official Entry Form.
- (3) The original of each emailed entry form must be supplied at Documentation.
- (4) Entries submitted before the Ordinary Entry Closing Date (see below) should be sent to:

- (5) The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the applicable provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

- (1) Entries open with the publication of these regulations.

4.4 Number of Starters: There is no maximum number of starters.

4.5 Multiple Drivers: Up to two (2) drivers per car entered are permitted. No additional entry fee is payable for a second driver.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING

5.1 Licence Requirements:

- (1) All drivers must hold as a minimum a Temporary M Grade Competition Licence.
- (2) Temporary M Grade Competition Licences may be purchased from the MotorSport NZ Steward on the day. A test is required.
- (3) Drivers holding a temporary M Grade Competition Licence may only compete in the Dual Car sprints.
- (4) To compete in the Multi Car sprint, each driver must have competed in two (2) dual sprints on the day and hold a full (not temporary) M Grade Licence.
- (5) If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- (1) The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations; and
- (2) The National Sporting Code Appendix Five, Schedule C.

5.3 All competitors must wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A of the National Sporting Code.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the National Sporting Code unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

6.2 Tyres: Racing tyres (including slicks) are allowed.

7. DOCUMENTATION, SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION AND DRIVERS' BRIEFINGS

7.1 Documentation: Documentation for all classes will take place at the Race Secretary's Office on the day of the Event from 08:00 – 08:45 or, if compliance with the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the Event requires a different location or method, at the location/by the method notified to entrants by the Organiser prior to or upon the driver's arrival at the Event.

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Scrutineering will take place at the same time as documentation at the Scrutineering Pavilion. Competitors will be advised at Documentation if their vehicle has been selected for an audit. Competitors should assume that their vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence, is in readiness to be taken to the audit venue immediately after they have completed Documentation. If compliance with the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the Event requires a different location or method, the audit will take place at the location/by the method notified to entrants by the Organiser prior to or upon the driver's arrival at the Event.

7.3 Drivers' briefings:

- (1) Subject to (2) below, this briefing will be held at 09:00 at a place announced by PA announcement prior to the event. Attendance is compulsory and a roll-call will be made.
- (2) The location and method of holding each briefing may change, event to event, according to the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the event.

8. POSTPONEMENT AND CANCELLATION

8.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, if less than 30 entries are received for an Event by the **Ordinary Entry Closing Date** for that Event, the Event may be postponed or cancelled.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 Passengers: Unless compliance with the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order in force as at the date of the event precludes passengers, passengers may be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2 of the National Sporting Code.

10.2 Fuel: Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the Motorsport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel Handling. This can be found on the Motorsport NZ website – www.motorsport.org.nz.

10.3 Alcohol: Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

11. TIMEKEEPING

11.1 All competitors will be electronically timed using the AMB Transponder System.

11.2 All competitors must have an operational AMB transponder approved for car or motorcycle racing, fitted for all testing, qualifying sessions and races.

11.3 For those competitors who do not have their own transponder, hire units are available from the Race Secretary's office. The hire charge is set out under Entry Fees above. Competitors

who compete in the Clubmans Race Meeting the day after an Event need to pay a second hire fee for the Clubmans Meeting.
